SHOW RULES and IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1) Market steers must be made available for weigh-in between 7:30 A.M. and 8:30 A.M. No steers will be re-weighed.
- 2) Heifers must check in by 9:00 A.M.
- 3) Cattle may arrive any time after 5:00 P.M. on Friday, April 21st. Exhibitor must provide own bedding. (Shavings only)
- 4) Fitting is optional for Cattle Showmanship.
- 5) Heifers must have been born between 5-1-15 and 12-31-16, inclusive. Registration must be presented at check-in.
- 6) Market lambs and ewe lambs must be made available for weigh-in between 9:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. on the day of the show. Lamb classes will be determined by weights. No lambs will be weighed after 10:00 A.M. and no lambs will be re-weighed.
- 7) Lambs will be shown out of the trailer. No stall area or pens will be provided.
- 8) All lambs exhibited must have a Premises ID or Scrapie Ear Tag issued through the USDA Scrapie Eradication Program. For additional information contact the USDA veterinary offices at 1-866-873-2824.
- 9) All lambs will be inspected for absence of Club Lamb Fungus. No unsightly conditions, active or healed lesions of Club Lamb Fungus will be tolerated or permitted.
- 10) All lambs must be slick shorn before crossing the scales. **Maximum weight for market lambs is 160 pounds.**
- 11) Ewe ages: Yearlings ewes, fall and spring lambs. All ewe lambs will be broke by weight. Sheep shown as lambs must have all lambs teeth. Ewe Lambs may enter both breeding and market. Ewes will not be shown by breed.
- 12) Health certificates that are from within 30 days will be required for all out of state livestock. Animals must be individually listed and identified on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Please contact the ODA at 503-986-4680 with questions.
- 13) The animals must be shown by the exhibitor, except that if the exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, another exhibitor may show the other animal in that class.
- 14) **This is a JUNIOR EXHIBITORS SHOW. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger on the day of the show.**
- 15) Exhibitors must control their animals in a show ring manner at all times.
- 16) Entries must be postmarked by April 1, 2017. Late entries will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 per animal and **only cash** will be accepted. No clothing pre-orders will be accepted after April 1st.
- 17) Exhibitors must show their own animal in Showmanship classes. Prizes will be awarded in four divisions, according to the age of the exhibitor: Peewees (3rd grade and under); Junior Division (4th-6th grade); Intermediate Division (7th-9th grade); Senior Division (10th grade- Age 21)
- 18) The show committee reserves the right to make any changes or exceptions necessary for the betterment of the show.
- 19) All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the show committee, the Douglas County Livestock Association, the sponsors, or the Douglas County Fairgrounds are not responsible for any loss or damage that may arise to livestock, persons, or property at the show. Each exhibitor is responsible for any loss or damage arising from any animal exhibited by him/her to another.
