SHOW RULES and IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1) Posted show schedule is subject to change.
- 2) Market steers must be made available for weigh-in during the scheduled weigh-in times on the day of the show. No steers will be re-weighed. Heifers must check-in with paperwork at the show office.
- 3) Cattle may arrive anytime after 5:00 P.M. on Friday, April 17th. Exhibitor must provide own bedding. (Shavings only)
- 4) Heifers must have been born between 5-1-18 and 12-31-19, inclusive. Registration must be presented at check-in or will show as a crossbred.
- 5) Fitting is optional for Cattle Showmanship.
- 6) Market lambs and ewe lambs must be made available for weigh-in during the scheduled weigh-in times on the day of the show. Lamb classes will be determined by weights. No lambs will be re-weighed.
- 7) Lambs will be shown out of the trailer. No stall area or pens will be provided.
- 8) All lambs exhibited must have a **Premises ID or Scrapie Ear Tag issued through the USDA Scrapie Eradication Program.** For additional information contact the USDA veterinary offices at 1-866-873-2824.
- 9) **All lambs will be inspected by a veterinarian for absence of Club Lamb Fungus and Sore Mouth prior to crossing the scale. No unsightly conditions, active or healed lesions of Club Lamb Fungus or Sore Mouth will be tolerated or permitted.**
- 10) All lambs must be slick shorn before crossing the scales. **Maximum weight for market lambs is 160 pounds.**
- 11) Ewe ages: Yearlings ewes, fall and spring lambs. All ewe lambs will be broke by weight. Sheep shown as lambs must have all lamb teeth. Ewe Lambs may enter both breeding and market classes. Ewes will not be shown by breed.
- 12) **Douglas County class animals will show and be evaluated as part of the regular open show with a separate DC championship class comprised of the top two DC steers/market lambs in each open class.**
- 13) Health certificates that are from within 30 days will be required for all out of state livestock. Animals must be individually listed and identified on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Please contact the ODA at 503-986-4680 with questions.
- 14) Animals must be shown by the exhibitor, except that if the exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, another exhibitor may show the other animal in that class.
- 15) Showmanship animals must be shown in a market or breeding class
- 16) **This is a JUNIOR EXHIBITORS SHOW. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1st, 2020.**
- 17) Exhibitors must control their animals in a show ring manner at all times.
- 18) Entries must be entered online by April 15th. Late entries will be charged a late fee of \$20.00 per animal and **only cash** will be accepted. No clothing pre-orders will be accepted after April 15th.
- 19) Exhibitors must show their own animal in Showmanship classes. Prizes will be awarded in four divisions, according to the age of the exhibitor: Peewees (3rd grade and under); Junior Division (4th-6th grade); Intermediate Division (7th-9th grade); Senior Division (10th grade– Age 21)
- 20) All overnight camping including dry lot camping anywhere on fairgrounds property is required to pay camping fees.
- 21) The show committee reserves the right to make any changes or exceptions necessary for the betterment of the show.
- 22) All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the show committee, the Douglas County Livestock Association, the sponsors, or the Douglas County Fairgrounds are not responsible for any loss or damage that may arise to livestock, persons, or property at the show. Each exhibitor is responsible for any loss or damage arising from any animal exhibited by him/her to another.
